



## MAYOR'S MESSAGE

I am pleased to announce that the City has secured funding for two key projects from the Federal Government that will contribute greatly to our future growth and economic development and will achieve our aspiration of a healthy and sustainable natural environment.

A total of \$3.05 million has been awarded to enable the Rail Smart Program and the Yellagonga Wetlands Smart Sensor Monitoring Program to be activated. Both projects harness technology, innovation and data

to help support strategic decision making to enhance our growing community and improve the lives of residents.

The Rail Smart Program will analyse public transport data gathered from train users at Clarkson, Butler, Joondalup and other train stations, which will then be used to inform the design of the future stations of Alkimos, Eglinton and Yanchep.

The Yellagonga Wetlands Smart Sensor Monitoring Program will introduce environmental sensors to manage and protect the Yellagonga wetland system.

Once established, the Program will assist the City and our partners to respond more quickly to

environmental concerns as they arise and inform the community on critical environmental information about the wetlands.

As we welcome summer, it is timely to remind everyone that vehicles are not permitted on any of the City's beaches.

Families use our beaches and we have received a high number of complaints of illegal four-wheel-driving putting families at risk.

As a result, Rangers and drones will be out in force on our beaches this summer and will be issuing \$500 penalties to any unauthorised vehicles caught on a City of Wanneroo beach.

These tough measures will help to ensure the safety of beachgoers while

protecting our foreshores and dune systems which are susceptible to erosion.

The City's Public Health Plan, Access and Inclusion Plan and Reconciliation Action Plan are currently being reviewed.

## Food trucks coming to parks near you



Food trucks will start operating in the coming fortnight as the extended trial continues at sites across the City of Wanneroo.

The food trucks will operate on week nights and weekends throughout

summer and until June 2018.

The City has been working with volunteer Community Food Truck Coordinators to develop a new schedule of trading locations, days and times.

Depending on the location, between five and 10 trucks will be in operation from Tuesdays to Sundays, with some trading from lunchtime while others will start from 5.30pm.

During the extension of the trial, the food truck operating model will be further refined, in respect of the best trading locations and times.

Consultation was also undertaken with relevant sporting clubs, community groups and businesses near trial locations to ensure they are supportive.

Surveys from the trial launch early this year found 98.5% of residents supported food truck trading within the City, and nearly 80% were keen to see vendors trade all year round.

The trial also indicated residents were exploring different places within the City, with more than 70% of those surveyed saying they would not have gone to that location if the food truck was not there.

In the north-coastal parts of the City food vans will be located at:

- Avondale Park, Mindarie
- Shorehaven Beach, Alkimos, and
- Fisherman's Hollow, Yanchep.

New locations may be added during the extended trial period.
