

### **CONDITIONS OF USE**

- The Beach Trekker is available to the Public free of charge.
- Bookings are essential via: [www.wanneroo.wa.gov.au/bechwheelchairs](http://www.wanneroo.wa.gov.au/bechwheelchairs)
- Bookings will be confirmed with an automatic email and will provide hirers with access details and key collection.
- All users and carers operating the Beach Trekker are to thoroughly read all safety information and conditions of use prior to venturing onto the beach.
- Surf Life Saving Staff and Volunteers are merely custodians of the key. Their primary responsibility is water safety and as such cannot provide assistance with transfers or helping people to use the beach wheelchairs.
- Surf Life Saving Staff and Volunteers have the right to cancel any bookings if beach conditions are not suitable.
- Any enquiries regarding the Beach Trekker can be made by contacting the City's Community Development Team on 9405 5600.

### **COLLECTION AND RETURN**

- The Beach Trekker is available from Store Room 4 at the Quinns Mindarie Community Centre, located at 2 Quinns Road, Mindarie.
- Please refer to the image below and map on reverse for location of Storeroom and key collection.
- Hirers must provide their name and ID to the Duty Lifeguard on duty in order to collect the key.
- Hirers must ensure they collect and return the swipe access card within their allocated booking time.
- The Sandcruiser must be returned in the same condition as was hired, please ensure the Sandcruiser is thoroughly rinsed with fresh water and is free of sand upon return.
- Hirers must ensure that the Storeroom is locked after each use.
- Any damages or mechanical problems are to be reported to the City of Wanneroo Community Development Team on 9405 5600.
