

## **CONDITIONS OF USE**

- The Sandcruiser is available to the Public free of charge
- Bookings will be confirmed with an automatic email and will provide hires with details of swipe access card collection
- Hires will be required to collect the swipe access card from the Lifeguard on duty at the time of their booking
- All users and carers operating the Sandcruiser are to thoroughly read all safety information and conditions of use prior to venturing onto the beach
- All users are required to complete a user form before using the Sandcruiser
- Any enquiries regarding the Sandcruiser can be made by contacting the City's Community Development Team on 9405 5600
- Surf Life Saving Staff and Volunteers are merely custodians of the key. Their primary responsibility is water safety and as such cannot provide assistance with transfers or helping people to use the beach wheelchairs.

## **COLLECTION AND RETURN**

- The Sandcruiser will be made available from the Yanchep Surf Life Saving Club first aid room. Please refer to the image and map below for location of first aid room and swipe access card collection. Bookings must be made for collection and return.



- Hirers must display their booking confirmation email to the Lifeguard on duty in order to collect the swipe access card
- Hirers must ensure they collect and return the swipe access card within their allocated booking time
- The Sandcruiser must be returned in the same condition as was hired
- Hirers must ensure that the first aid room is locked after each use
- Please ensure that for the safety and comfort of future users, the Sandcruiser is thoroughly rinsed with fresh water and is free of sand upon return
- Any damages or mechanical problems are to be reported to the City of Wanneroo Community Development Team on 9405 5600.
