Enlisted in the A.I.F. at Perth early in the year 1915, and sailed for Egypt on November 2nd of the same year. From Egypt he proceeded to France, where he saw fighting at Pozieres, and he was unfortunate enough to break his arm. He was in hospital for a short period, and when he recovered he returned to his battalion and fought in many battles, including Bullecourt. On May 6th, 1917, he was reported missing at Bullecourt, but advice was received later that he had been killed. Private White had many sincere friends, who have great sympathy for his parents, Mr. Henry and Mrs. Ann White, who reside at 823 Wellington Street, Perth, W.A.
