TENDER 20015: PROVISION OF PLUMBING SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS

Issue

To consider Tender No: 20015 for the Provision of Plumbing Services for a Period of Three (3) Years.

Background

The City is seeking to appoint a suitably qualified and experienced contractor to provide plumbing services on both a scheduled program and an as-and-when required basis for all City assets. This is a recurring contract for a period of three (3) years with options to extend, at the City's discretion for a further two (2), one (1) year terms or part thereof. The current Contract expires on 31 May 2020.

Detail

Tender 20015 for the Provision of Plumbing Services was advertised on 7 March 2020 and closed on Tuesday 31 March 2020. A total of three (3) addenda were issued in response to clarifications sought and which did not change the intent or scope of work included to the original tender document.

Probity Oversight

Oversight to the tender assessment process was undertaken by the City's Contracts Officer.

Pricing is not included in the qualitative criteria and is considered as part of the overall value for money assessment. A minimum acceptable baseline for Qualitative Criteria was required together with acceptable minimum scores required for each designated qualitative criterion indicated with * in the table above.

All received tender submissions were deemed as conforming.

Evaluation Criteria 1 – Sustainable (Corporate Social Responsibility) Procurement (20%)

Evidence of Sustainable (Corporate Social Responsibility) Procurement was assessed based on the tenderers' responses provided within the Questionnaires

provided in Schedules 3A, 3B, 3C, 3D which were included in the tender documentation.

Evaluation Criteria 1a – Environmental Considerations (5%)

The City is committed to procuring goods and services that have the most positive environmental, social and economic impacts over the entire life cycle of a product or service. Tenderers were encouraged to provide the credentials of any environmental claims for the goods and/or services being submitted in this Tender.

Evaluation Criteria 2 - Tenderer's OSH demonstrated working documents (20%)

Evidence of safety and quality management policies and practices was assessed from the tender submissions. The assessment for safety management was based on the tenderer's responses to an Occupational Health and Safety Management System Questionnaire and evidence for workplace implementation of those systems included within the tender documentation.

Evaluation Criteria 3 - Tenderer's methodology, resources and capacity for maintenance services (25%)

The tenderer's resources as presented in their tender submission were assessed in order to evaluate their capacity to meet the requirements of the contract. Assessment of this criterion considered the tenderer's staff resources, vehicles, plant/equipment and workshop support to manage the contract.

Evaluation Criteria 4 - Demonstrated experience of tendering entity and personnel performing the services (35%)

The tenderer's relevant experience in demonstrating the achievement of meeting client expectations as presented in their tender submission were assessed in order to evaluate their capability to meet the requirements of the contract. Assessment of this criterion considered the credentials of the tendering entity and personnel performing the services to fulfil the requirements of the contract.

All tenderers met the minimum requirement for this evaluation criterion.

Overall Qualitative Weighted Assessment and Ranking

Tenderer's submissions were reviewed and evaluated in accordance with the Procurement and Evaluation Plan with the following key observations:

- Price was not weighted and is included in the overall value for money assessment.
- Based on the information supplied for assessment, eight (8) of the 10 tenderers achieved a minimum acceptable score for each designated qualitative criteria.

Overall Assessment and Comment

The highest ranked tenderer, Diamond Plumbing and Gas failed to meet the City's minimum requirements for financial risk assessment.

The tender submission from On Tap Plumbing and Gas Pty Ltd as the next ranked tenderer satisfied the overall value for money assessment and met the City's financial assessment requirements.

On Tap Plumbing and Gas Pty Ltd is a locally based entity with their office located in Wangara, they consistently achieved acceptable baseline scores across all qualitative criteria assessments and is therefore recommended as the successful tenderer.

Financial and Performance Risk

Financial Risk

A financial risk assessment was undertaken as part of the tender evaluation process and the outcome of this independent assessment advised that On Tap Plumbing and Gas Pty Ltd has been assessed with having a "Satisfactory" financial capacity to meet the requirements of the contract. Recommendations stemming from the financial risk assessment will be incorporated into the terms of the contract.

Performance Risk

Independent reference checks have indicated that the recommended tenderer is reliable and produces work to a very high standard while maintaining alignment to budget and scheduling requirements without dispute or incident.

On Tap Plumbing and Gas Pty Ltd advises it has not been involved in any disputes or claims and it has not received or issued any notices of default over the past five (5) years.

Policy Implications

Tenders were invited in accordance with the requirements of the City's Purchasing Policy.

Financial (Budget) Implications

The costs associated with the Provision of Plumbing Services for a Period of Three (3) Years are included in the annual Asset Maintenance Service Unit Operational Budget.

Recommendation

That the Chief Executive Officer, in accordance with Delegation 1.1.14 (1) - Choice of Most Advantageous Tender of the Delegated Authority Register for the awarding of tenders ACCEPTS the tender submitted by On Tap Plumbing and Gas Pty Ltd for Tender 20015, for the Provision of Plumbing Services for a Period of Three (3) Years, with two (2), 12-month options to extend at the City's discretion and as per the schedule of rates in the tender submission.
