### What is a Section 70A Notification?

A Section 70A is a section of the Transfer of Land Act 1893 that allows notifications to be placed on a property's Certificate of Title.

The notifications advise prospective buyers of potential circumstances that might impact the enjoyment of that property. The City of Wanneroo or Western Australian Planning Commission can place conditions on a subdivision or development approval requiring a notification to be placed on the Certificate of Title of lot(s).

A notification could refer to any matter that may affect the use of the land or buildings on the land, and may need to be included on the Deposited/Survey-Strata Plan. Examples of common notices include:

<b>Bushfire Management Plans</b>	The site or part of the site is subject to a Bushfire Management Plan.
<b>Bushfire Prone Areas</b>	The site or part of the site falls within a 'bushfire prone area' as designed by an Order managed by the Fire and Emergency Services Commissioner under 18P of the <i>Fire and Emergency Services Act 1998</i> .
<b>Local Development Plans</b>	The site is subject to a Local Development Plan.
<b>Transport Corridor</b>	The site or part of the site is situated in the vicinity of a transport corridor and is currently effected, or may in the future be affected by transport noise.
<b>Contaminated Site</b>	The site or part of the site is contaminated.
<b>Hazards</b>	A hazard may affect the land, e.g. residential lots on land previously used as explosive depots.
<b>Pollution</b>	The land may be affected by emissions from a nearby land use, e.g. transport, noise, odour from poultry farm, dust from farms, noise from kennels.
<b>Water Supplies</b>	To advise that no reticulated water supply can be provided to the land by a licensed water services supplier and as a consequence, the owner will be required to make their own arrangements to provide an adequate water supply to the property.

The developer/landowner is required to pay all costs associated with the preparation and registration of a notification on a Certificate of Title under the Section 70A of the Transfer of Land Act.

It is recommended that solicitors or licenced surveyors are used to prepare and register the Section 70A notification documentation with Landgate.

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Reference to affixing the Council's Common Seal on the 'Notification Under Section 70A' documentation is unnecessary as execution of the documentation is performed by authorised officers within Council in accordance with the Execution of Document Policy.

Please ensure no reference is made to affixing the Common Seal, as this can result in delays to forms being signed and returned.

**How do I lodge a Section 70A Notification with the City?**

The following documentation is required to be lodged with the City in hardcopy form:

- Completed Form N1 – Notification under Section 70A [Landgate](#)  
*(The form must be printed as a double sided document and executed by the Registered Proprietors prior to lodgement with the City)*
- Copy of the Proposed Plan of Survey
- Copy of the relevant Subdivision Approval or Development Application Approval listing the notification condition.
- Copy of Relevant Plan (FMP, LDP, Transport Noise Assessment) *if require*
