I will ask the Cockman House worker or _____ if I am not sure.

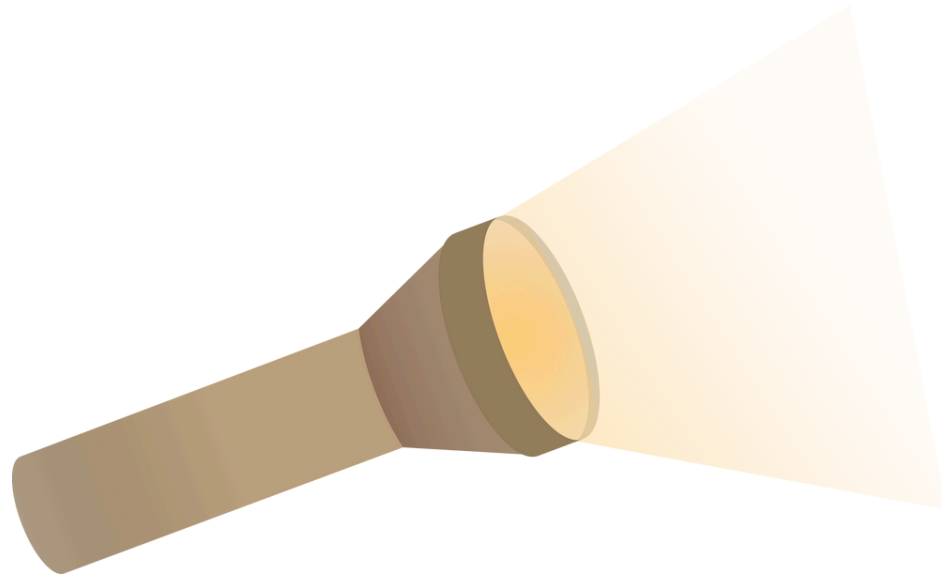


I will stay with _____ to make sure I am safe.
