Items must be rinsed, empty and loose in the bin

- Glass bottles and jars (lids removed)
- Plastic bottles and containers (lids removed)
- Clean cardboard (flattened)
- Paper (not shredded)
- ✗ Hazardous or electronic waste

- Grass cuttings
 Leaves/flowers
- Prunings and small branches
- Weeds, sticks and twigs
- ✗ Food waste
- Animal droppings and bedding

- ✗ Building materials
