What can go in your **general waste** bin
(collected weekly)



- ✓ Food waste
- ✓ Unrepairable clothing
- ✓ Nappies/sanitary items
- ✓ Shredded/dirty paper
- ✓ Dirty cardboard (flattened)
- ✓ Animal droppings and bedding
- ✓ Garden organics
- ✗ Hazardous or electronic waste - take to your nearest drop off centre

What can go in your **recycling** bin
(collected fortnightly)



- Items must be rinsed, empty and loose in the bin
- ✓ Aluminium and steel cans
 - ✓ Glass bottles and jars (lids removed)
 - ✓ Plastic bottles and containers (lids removed)
 - ✓ Clean cardboard (flattened)
 - ✓ Paper (not shredded)
 - ✗ Hazardous or electronic waste

SORTING YOUR WASTE - THREE BINS



What can go in your **garden organics (GO) bin**

(collected fortnightly)



Keep it loose (no bags)

- ✓ Grass cuttings
- ✓ Leaves/flowers
- ✓ Prunings and small branches
- ✓ Weeds, sticks and twigs
- ✗ Food waste
- ✗ Animal droppings and bedding
- ✗ Glass or ceramics
- ✗ Building materials

What can go in your **general waste bin**

Items to be rinsed, empty and loose in the bin

- ✓ Aluminium and steel cans
- ✓ Glass bottles and jars*
- ✓ Plastic bottles and containers*
- ✓ Clean cardboard (flattened)
- ✓ Paper (not shredded)
- ✗ Hazardous or electronic waste
