Kingsway Indoor Stadium gets ready for COVID kick-off!

Tradespeople have temporarily replaced players on the courts of Kingsway Indoor Stadium in Madeley as the Centre prepares to reopen.

The City was required to shut Kingsway's doors to patrons in order to comply with social distancing measures and the closure has allowed the City to bring forward maintenance works which include recoating and resurfacing courts, lighting upgrades and painting.

Mayor Tracey Roberts said sports players and fitness class participants can expect to return to a fresh, upgraded facility when Kingsway reopens.

"Not only will our courts look great, they will provide better grip underfoot - providing a safer and more enjoyable environment for players and participants," said Mayor Roberts.

Meanwhile at Wanneroo Aquamotion, the City used the shutdown for a range of improvements including new hot water systems and upgrades to plant equipment.

"By conducting these works during the shutdown, the City has been able to provide better facilities for the community - whilst generating work for local tradespeople and suppliers," said Mayor Roberts.
