Today we officially opened the Leatherback Park Pavilion in Alkimos. The \$1.8 million Leatherback sporting facility delivers modern amenities for local sporting groups.

This premier sporting precinct will help cater for our rapidly growing population, and give our residents access to facilities that encourage healthy, active lifestyles and community connections.

The park is a shared use oval with Alkimos Beach Primary School and will be used by the Alkimos Pirates Lacrosse Club, Alkimos Ball Club, Brighton Seahawks Junior Football Club and West Perth District Football.

The park features a bicycle education track, a playing field suitable for a number of sports, change rooms, a first aid room, kitchen and kiosk, and a multi-purpose room.

I am sure families and individuals will enjoy the many amenities and surrounds at Leatherback Park.

It was wonderful to see so many people attend last Saturday's WAFL game between the West Coast Eagles and West Perth at Splendid

There will also be a service and a parade at the memorial in Yanchep National Park from 10.30am.

RAAFA Cambrai Village in Merriwa will also hold a morning service at 85 Hester Avenue from 10am.

This year marks 100 years since the Royal Australian Air Force formed, and the theme is Flying Into a New Era: 100 Years of RAAF.

Annual Community Waste Drop-Off Day

If you have been waiting to dispose of unwanted household items, the time has come.

The City of Wanneroo's free annual Community Waste Drop-Off Day will be held this Saturday.

The City is committed to providing residents with opportunities to reduce, reuse and recycle waste. Residents can discard a range of items including:

Cardboard and polystyrene

• Tyres: Maximum four tyres per household. Residents must show driver's licence or rates notice to drop off tyres. Passenger vehicle and motorcycle tyres only no commercial tyres.

• Clothing: Registered charities will be on site to collect unwanted clothing, textiles, manchester, bedding, towels and shoes.

• E-waste: Computers, laptops, mobile phones, hard drives, CDs and floppy drives (computer only), inkjet and laserjet printers, LCD, Plasma and CRT monitors and televisions, modems, keyboards, mice and joysticks, fax machines, electronic cables and wiring.
