

My Visit to the Wanneroo Regional Museum



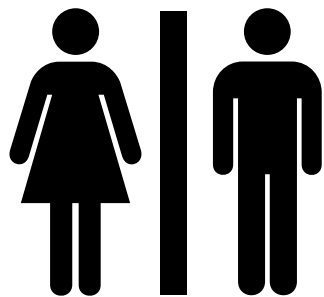

The Wanneroo Museum is in a building called the Wanneroo Library and Cultural Centre. It is a two storey building. The museum is on the ground floor.

I can ask for ear muffs and a sensory bag to make my visit more enjoyable.



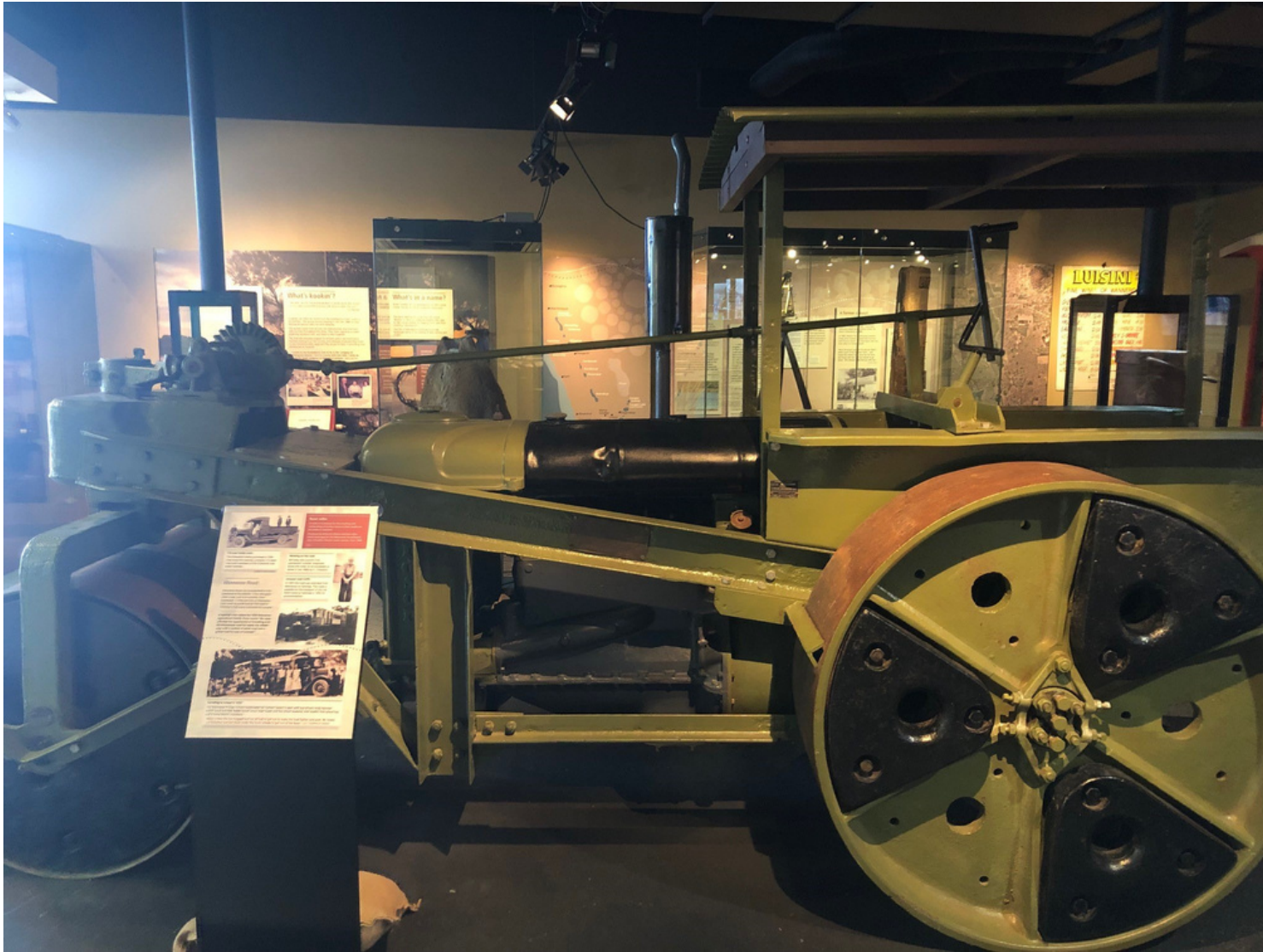
There are lots of objects in the museum for me to explore, as well as images and sounds. These will help me learn about the history of Wanneroo.

I will tell the museum worker or _____ if I feel
uncomfortable.
I can use the torch in my sensory bag if I need it.



It might get noisy in the museum.

If I get upset with the noise I will ask the museum worker
or _____ to help me find a quiet place.

I can put on the ear muffs.



There are seats around the museum
for me to sit and have a rest.



I can drink from my water bottle in the museum.
I must not eat food or have other drinks in the museum.



When I have finished my visit I will return the ear muffs and sensory bag if I have borrowed them.



I will collect my bag if I left it at the front desk.
