

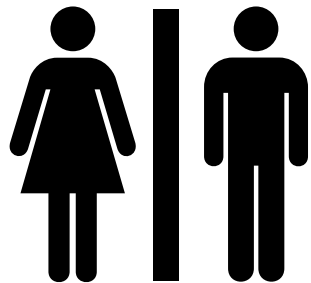
# My Visit to the Wanneroo Regional Museum

On \_\_\_\_\_ I will be going to the Wanneroo Museum.



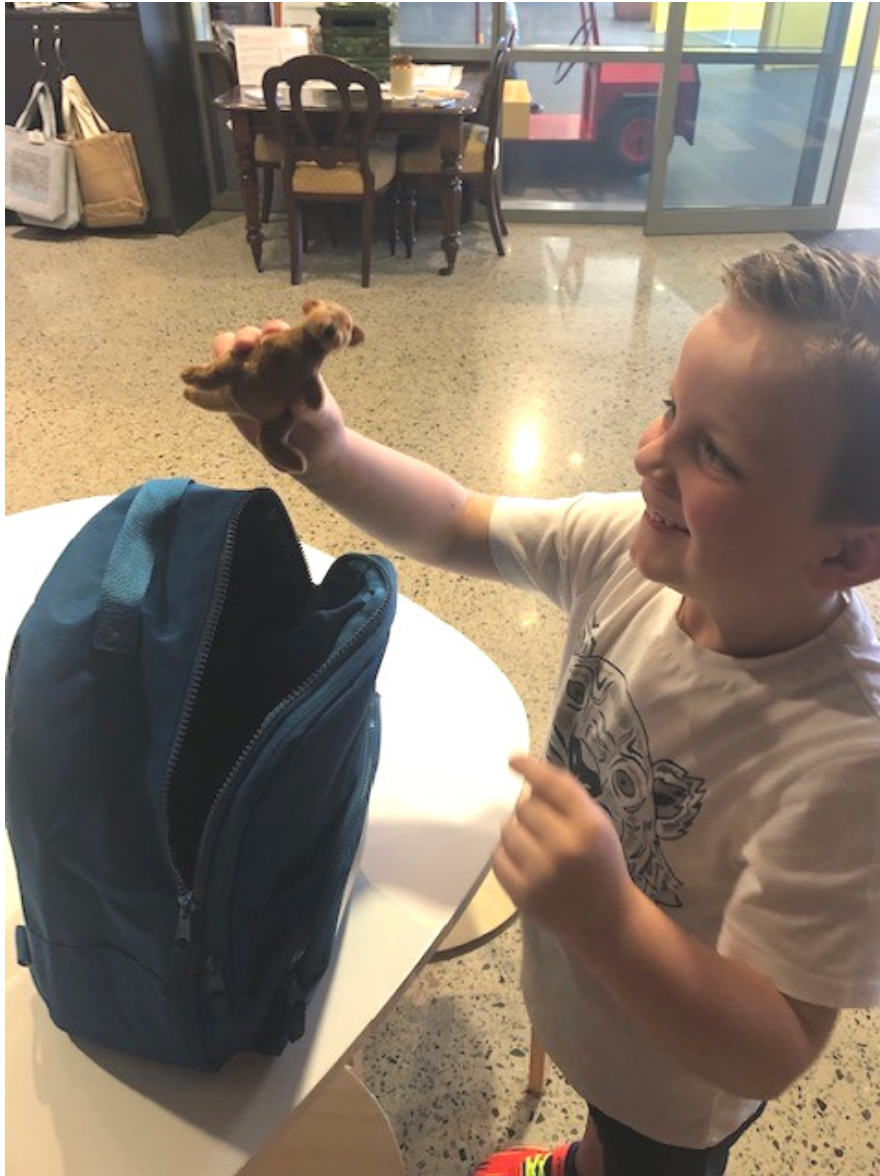
The toilets are next to the museum.



I will enter the museum and be greeted by a museum worker. Museum workers wear a name badge and sunflower lanyard. They will help me if I have any questions.



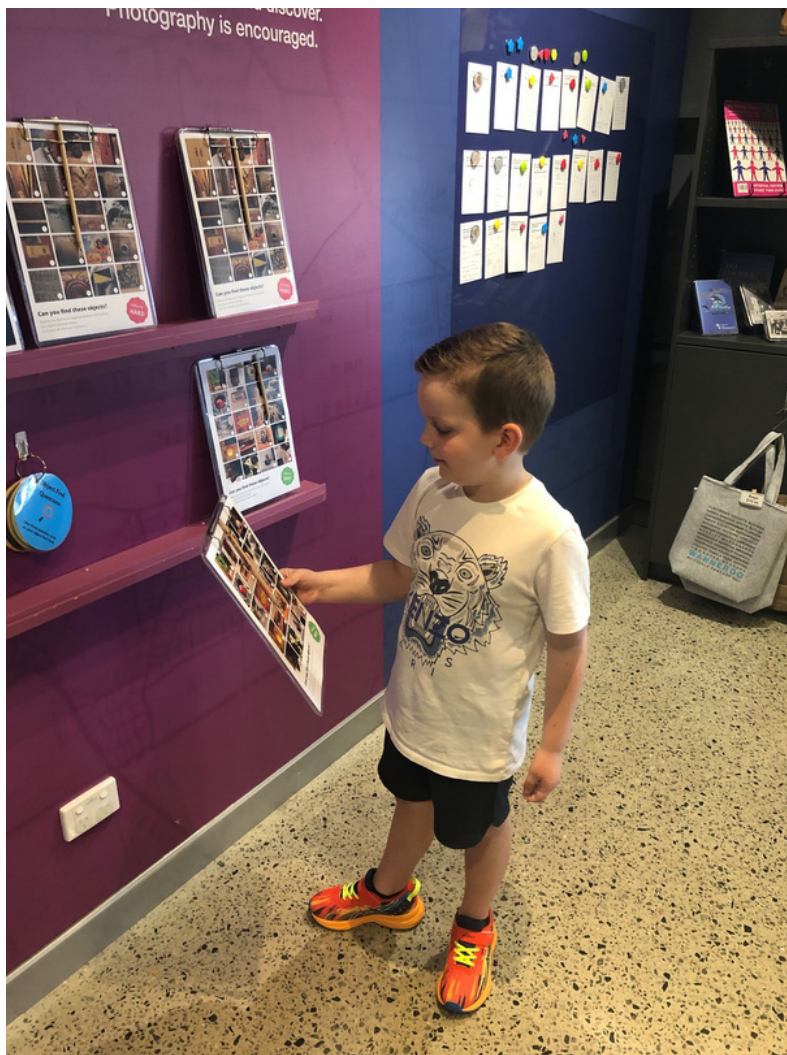
I can ask the museum worker to look after my bag while I look around.

There are lots of objects in the museum for me to explore, as well as images and sounds. These will help me learn about the history of Wanneroo.

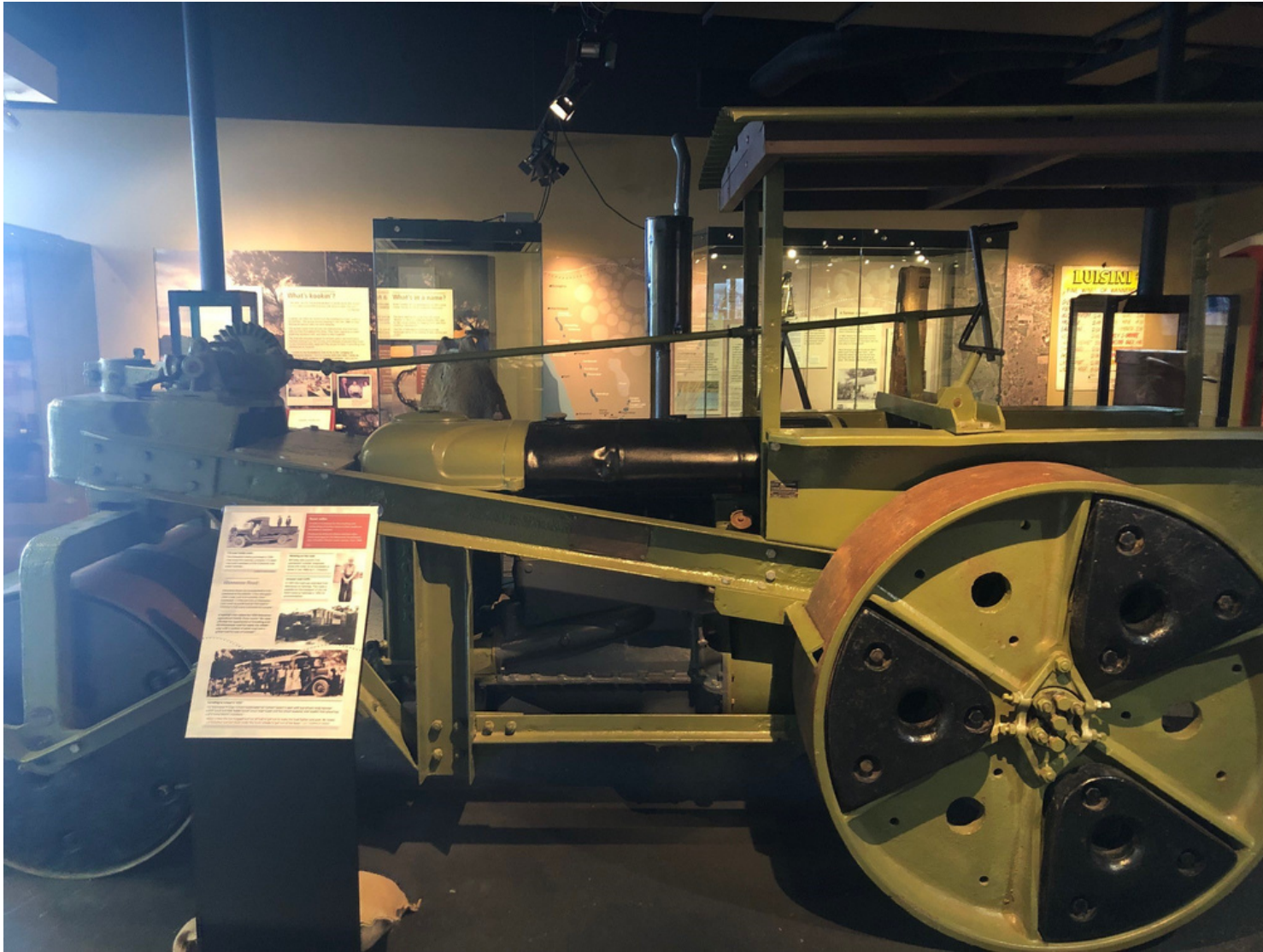


I can choose an activity clipboard to help me find things in the museum.

I will collect my bag if I left it at the welcome desk.
