

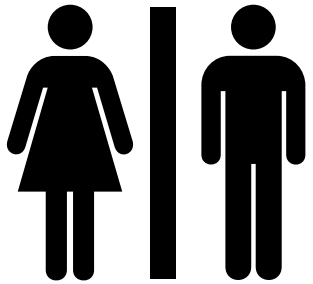
My Buckingham House Excursion

Classroom: matchstick shape building



In the classroom we will make some shapes using matchsticks.

We will have some pictures we can follow.



In the other room we will do some sewing.
We will get to choose a piece of coloured yarn.
The adult helpers will help us sew.



After finishing one activity we will swap rooms and do the other activity.

Let an adult know if the noise upsets you.
