# My Buckingham House Excursion



On \_\_\_\_\_ we will be going to Buckingham House.



We will get on a bus, which will take us to Buckingham House. Some of the kids in the class might be loud as they will be excited.





The toilets are behind Buckingham House.

If you need to go to the toilet during the excursion let an adult know.



We will sit on a mat and be greeted by a Buckingham House worker. They will tell us about all the fun things we will be doing there.



We will meet some volunteers.

Volunteers are adults who will help us with the activities.

There are 4 activities we will do on the excursion.

We will do 2 activities before recess and

after recess. We will do the activities in a small group with an adult helper.



When we hear a bell ring it is time to move to the next activity.

Our adult helper will show us where to go.

#### Sewing





Inside Buckingham House we will do some sewing. We will get to choose 2 pieces of coloured yarn. The adult helpers will help us sew the letter B for Buckingham.



Then the adult helpers will tell us about some objects.

#### Kitchen





In the kitchen we will do some baking. We will wash our hands and put an apron on. We will then get to make a bread called damper.



Then we will get to look inside the kids' bedroom.



We then get to ring the bell. The bell is called a cow bell. The bell is loud. Let an adult know if this upsets you.

### Old Schoolhouse



The Old Wanneroo Schoolhouse is next to Buckingham House.



In the school we will have a school lesson. We will get to write on a chalkboard.



The adult helper will show us the dunce hat and cane. We are just pretending. If you would rather just watch that is okay.

## Laundry



In the laundry we will do some old fashioned washing. We will wash a piece of fabric on a washing board.





We will get to look at lots of different objects in the laundry. We will hang the piece of fabric on a washing line.

#### Recess



After doing 2 activities it is time for recess. We will get to eat some of the damper and drink some water.

If you do not want the damper let an adult know.



We will get to play with some old- fashioned toys. We need to share the toys. It might get noisy because everyone is having fun playing. Let an adult know if the noise upsets you.



When we hear the bell ring it is time to pack up the toys and sit back on the mat. We will go back into our group with our adult helper and do 2 more activities.



At the end of the excursion we will get to see the water pump.



Our teacher will collect our sewing and damper. We will get on the bus and go back to school.
