

We're improving bulk junk and bulk green waste collections in 2024



The City of Wanneroo is introducing a new pre-booked bulk junk and bulk green verge collection service in mid 2024.



The new service aims to make bulk collections more convenient, by allowing you to choose the next available pick-up time for your area.



The annual waste service fee covers one bulk junk and one bulk green waste collection per household every year.



The new service aims to increase recycling and resource recovery, cut down waste going to landfill, create cleaner, safer streets and reduce illegal dumping.

What's next?

The current scheduled bulk junk and bulk green collections will occur as usual throughout 2023 and early 2024.

We will share more information about the new pre-booked service ahead of the rollout, so you know what to expect and how to use the service.

The City currently keeps 39% of all collected waste out of landfill, through recycling, composting and resource recovery processes.
