

You are in a PSHB Quarantine Area

Polyphagous Shot-Hole Borer (PSHB) Quarantine Area requirements

Before leaving the Quarantine Area (QA):



Wood must be chipped to pieces that are less than 2.5 cm in size.



Living plants with woody stems greater than 2 cm must not leave the QA.



Machinery used to handle green waste must be cleaned of wood.



All wood and living plants must be securely transported in a fully sealed or covered skip bin, trailer, or truck.



A permit **is required** if these conditions are unable to be met.
