

Cockman House

Floor plan prediction activity instructions

Step 1.

Print out the floor plan in A3 and the object sheet in A4.

Step 2.

Cut out objects and predict which room they belong in.
You can glue the objects into the predicted rooms
Discuss why you think they belong there.

Step 3.

When your class visits Cockman House you can compare your predictions to the real thing.

You can use this after your excursion to remember the different rooms and objects.


This activity can be done as a whole class or in smaller groups.
