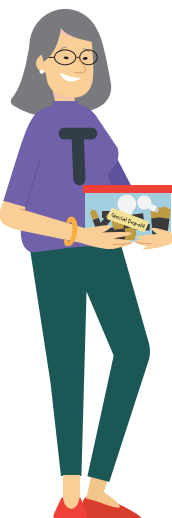




Free e-waste recycling for residents



Wangara Recycling Facility is now accepting e-waste, allowing residents to dispose of various unwanted electronics, free of charge.

You can now recycle electronic items such as computers and laptops, mobile phones, phone chargers, TVs, electrical cords, irons, drills, printers and USBs.

Simply use the free residential recycling voucher included in your annual rates notice.

This voucher can be used an unlimited number of times

throughout the year and should be presented when dropping off recyclables.

If you do not have a valid voucher, you can still use the facility for a fee.

Wangara Recycling Facility also accepts green waste and other recycling items, including batteries, cardboard, polystyrene and scrap metal.

Located at 70 Motivation Drive, Wangara, the facility is open 8am to 4.45pm on weekends and public holidays, excluding

Good Friday, Christmas Day and New Year's Day.

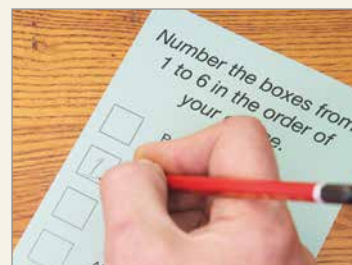
